WARRANT ARREST LEADS TO DEALING IN METHAMPHETAMINE CHARGE

On Tuesday, June 26, 2018 Officer Zachary Michael encountered Amanda East (age 38), who was known to have an outstanding warrant for her arrest, in the parking lot of the Circle K convenience store located at 504 West Temperance Street. East was taken into custody for the outstanding arrest warrant.

During East's arrest she was found to be in possession of suspected methamphetamine, marijuana, two pills found to be a controlled substance, syringes, a digital scale, drug paraphernalia, and other items indicative of the sale of illegal narcotics. In addition to the outstanding arrest warrant, East was also charged with Dealing in Methamphetamine, a Level 5 felony, Possession of a Syringe, a Level 6 felony, Possession of a Controlled Substance, a Class A misdemeanor, and Possession of Marijuana, a Class B misdemeanor.

Officers Camron Frye, Alec Leggio, Jared Myers, and Dustin White assisted with the arrest.

Criminal charges are merely accusations and defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
