### **ELLETTSVILLE POLICE OFFICERS SAVE VICTIM OF OVERDOSE**

ELLETTSVILLE, INDIANA (July 9, 2019): On Friday, July 5th, 2019, shortly after midnight, Sgt. Russell Harris, Deputy Marshal Zachary Michael, and Deputy Marshal Tyler Andis responded to the report of a heroin overdose on Chandler Drive in the Kelli Heights subdivision. Deputy Marshal Zachary Michael was the first to arrive on scene. When Deputy Marshal Michael arrived he found an 18-year-old male unconscious and not breathing. Deputy Marshal Michael administered a single dose of Narcan (Naloxone) nasal spray and then started CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation). When Sgt. Harris arrived he provided Deputy Marshal Michael with a second dose of Narcan nasal spray to administer. After that second dose of Narcan the male was found to have a pulse and had started labored breathing on his own. Personnel from the Ellettsville Fire Department and the IU Health Bloomington Hospital Ambulance Service arrived shortly thereafter and assumed control of the medical treatment of the victim. By the time the male was transported to the hospital, he was able to speak and answer questions.
